Prairieways Action Plan

Published in GIS for Landscape Architects-ESRI

In partnership with The Greenway Team, DHM prepared Commerce City's Prairieways Action Plan. This master plan was for parks, trails, and open space with the goal of maintaining the quality of life for current and future residents, while preserving natural resources and open space from development. The 43 square mile area allows for connectivity to larger regional trails and a metro-wide trail and open space system.

Fort Missoula Regional Park

DHM was hired to develop and refine the Fort Missoula Regional Park Master Plan, used to gain consensus among all stakeholders, to develop accurate cost estimates for bonding, to develop desired phasing options, and to further the plan into the design development stage. Park theming was inspired by Civilian Conservation Corp era. including design of a championship soccer field, rugby fields, multi-use sports fields, picnic facilities, playgrounds, and a perimeter park trail. The park site has been nominated as a historic landscape.

DHM Design with The Greenway Team, prepared a greenway master plan for this one mile scenic corridor which runs through a hardwood forest in the heart of Anchorage, Kentucky. The greenway provides an important link between the city's newest town center, schools, businesses, neighborhoods and the "Tom" Sawyer State Park to the west. The project includes a 300' span signature pedestrian bridge, natural trails, an amphitheater, a fishing pier, a wetland boardwalk, gateway features and an interpretive wayfinding display throughout.

Working with the City of Commerce City, DHM prepared a master plan for a five mile segment of Sand Creek providing a regional trail connection to the South Platte River and the Stapleton Redevelopment Area.
